Blood Drives for 2013

Making a Difference Through Blood

The importance of donating blood cannot be overstated. The need is constant and the need is great. Every 2 seconds someone in America needs blood. Each year approximately 5 million patients receive blood. More than 44,000 blood donations are needed every single day. Despite our advanced level of science and technology in this great country, there is no way to artificially manufacture blood...it must come from us human beings! The number of blood donors in the U.S. in one year is 9.5 million (a very small percentage of our population). Considering less than 38% of the U.S. population is eligible to donate blood, it makes it that much more critical that if we can, we should.

The Masonic District 54 Blood Program made significant advances in 2012, collecting 119 units at the five blood drives. When added to the number of units collected outside of the actual blood drives, our brethren, families, and friends donated 242 units between Dec 2011 and Nov 2012. Considering one pint of blood can save up to three lives, this is a real impact.

I want to thank all the lodges who hosted our 2012 blood drives, the lodges who provided the superb breakfasts, and let's not forget the amazing Red Cross professionals who are so skilled at "sticking" us. To those brothers, family, friends and others who donated, my deepest thanks for stepping up and making a difference.

For 2013 we are going to ratchet things up just a bit. We have confirmed with the Red Cross six blood drives this year: February 9th, April 6th, Jun 1st, Aug 3rd, Oct 5th, and Dec 7th. Subject to the Master's OK, Cherrydale will have the canteen for the June 1st and Dec 7th drives being hosted at KMW Lodge #64. I highly encourage you to come out, give blood, and make a difference!
