Many know that the Masonic Home started in 1890 as a home for orphans and shifted to serving adults in 1955. The Grand Lodge of Virginia was not the first to establish a home – many Grand Lodges formed homes to serve the needs of Brothers in the fullness of their years. The Masonic Services Association reported that 34 Grand Lodges currently sponsor and maintain retirement communities programs. The Masonic Home of Virginia is, however, among a small number of Masonic facilities that still requires that applicants be masonically connected. As of September – 219 of our Brothers, their wives and widows reside in the home. The responsibility to maintain the Home and care for our Brothers there falls to us.

As is Cherrydale's custom, we will pool our contributions to the Masonic Home of Virginia during our second stated communication on October 17th and will send them down to Richmond. If you are going to be in Lodge that night – you can bring cash or check. If you can't be here, I ask you please to make a contribution to the Masonic Home of Virginia and send it in early to ensure that your support is included with that of your Brothers in the Lodge.
