Brethren,

The Mentor’s Manual instructs us that Masonic Visitation – or the practice of travel in foreign countries – is the right of every Master Mason in good standing and one of the “most widely used and enjoyed rights as practiced in Virginia.” It is a practice that strengthens the bonds among Brothers from different Lodges and increases the knowledge of the Brother who travels as he experiences subtle differences in the way Lodges perform their duties within the bounds of our great Masonic tradition.

One goal Cherrydale has set for this year is to conduct at least one fraternal visit to each of the Lodges in the 54th Masonic District. To complete this task successfully, 5 or more of our Master Masons must visit a District Lodge together during one of its stated meetings. During the course of the meeting, usually during introductions, one brother can then request a fraternal visit from the Brethren of Cherrydale Lodge be noted in the minutes. It is that easy!

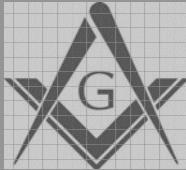
