THE RESEARCH LODGES

Brethren,

A research lodge is a special lodge dedicated to conducting and preserving Masonic research, thereby expanding the body of knowledge about Freemasonry. They are not normal lodges. They do not conduct degrees, and you have to be a Master Mason and belong to another symbolic lodge in order to petition a research lodge. This is not entirely accurate, but think of it as an appendant body dedicated to Masonic research.

A. Douglas Smith Lodge of Research No. 1949, our local research lodge, meets on the fifth Saturday of the month at 10 a.m. in the North Room of the GW Masonic Memorial in Alexandria. Another one recently started working down in Fredericksburg. Some research lodges, such as the Southern California Research Lodge, can be joined at a distance and mail out their transactions. The Civil War Lodge of Research and the Pennsylvania Lodge of Research have regular meetings that travel to different locations. Washington, DC has Pythagoras Lodge of Research, which meets at Singleton Masonic Hall. Many more research lodges are out there, waiting for you to discover them.

The next meeting of A. Douglas Smith Lodge of Research is March 30. I would love to have you join me for the meeting. A good time is guaranteed. Please contact me with any questions.

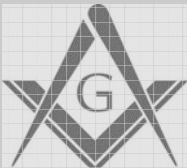
