FROM THE EAST

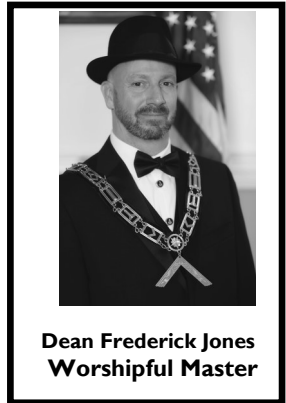
This month's message is from our Senior Warden, while the Worshipful Master enjoys a well-deserved vacation and birthday celebration. Happy birthday Wor. Dean!

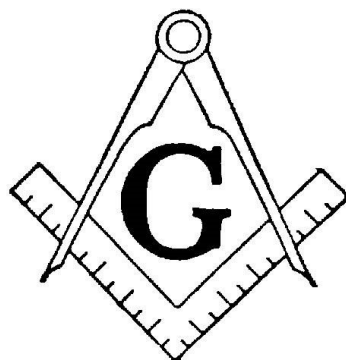

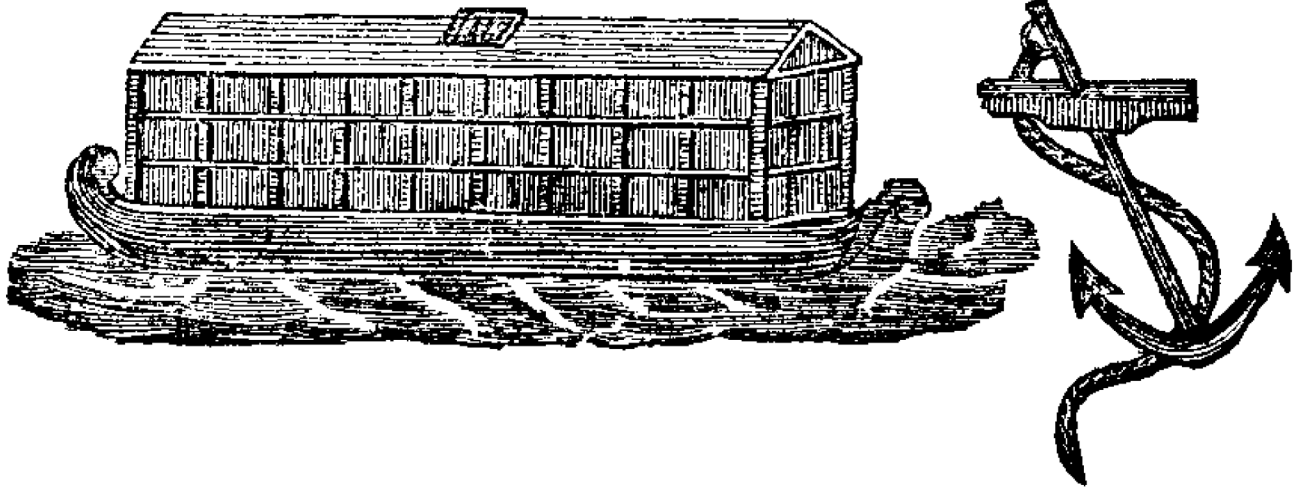
