FROM THE EAST

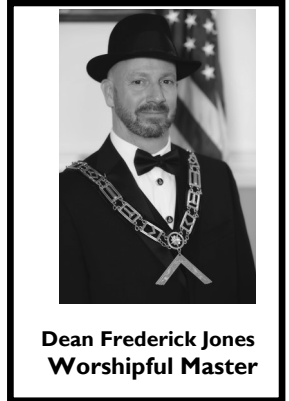
Brethren,
